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#### **DESCRIPTION OF E-LEARNING**

This e-Learning session is designed to help students study for their G1 road test in the province of Ontario. Keeping in mind the different age groups and people from different backgrounds, It is very well organized and worded, which makes it very easy to follow and understand. This easy to understand design helps students to navigate easily from one question to another. It will help students to get knowledge on all the road signs in terms of what they look like and what is the purpose of each sign. At the end of the test students will be provided with answer sheet so they are able to check how well they have done.

#### **OBJECTIVES**

  - a. Recognize all the road signs.
  - b. Determine what each road sign means.
- 2. Know all the rules of the road
  - a. List rules of the road

- b. From learning these rules you will gain an understanding on how to drive. This will prepare you mentally and give you confidence for your G2 test.
- Have gained knowledge on all the laws implemented by the government of Ontario for G1 license holder.
  - a. Again knowledge on all the laws.
  - b. How to follow the laws in order avoid breaking the laws.
- 4. Road safety and etiquettes of driving on the road.
  - a. To practice road safety you will gain knowledge on having a safe driving vehicle
  - b. Have proper etiquettes on driving safely while driving.

#### **AUDIENCE**

This e-learning session is built for people from the age of sixteen and up, who want to prepare for their G1 Road Test. The language used to build this e-learning program is easy to understand to assist those who are from different ethnic backgrounds. Not only is age and ethnicity taken into consideration but also the fact that everyone learns in a different ways. This e-learning is built with audio and video to accommodate all types of learners. It is designed in a way that makes it easier for everyone to understand the material.
